The District authority, the community leader

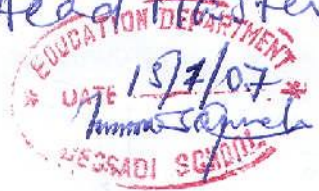
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and the School authority shall append their official stamp on this document for authentication. We really need your support and hope you shall come forward to give a helping hand.

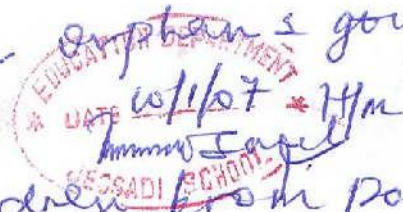


# THE SCHOOL NEED THE FOLLOWING

## MATERIALS:-

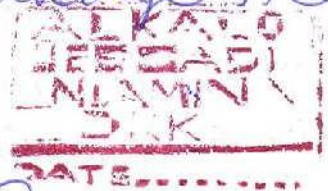

- 21. Radio Cassette, TV and a video for audio visual Teaching.

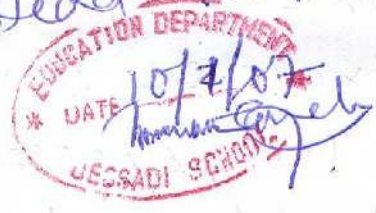
